2025/23) Matters Arising / Matters brought forward from other meetings

1. Enhanced highway maintenance scheme

The hedge cutting that was mentioned at the last meeting is not an issue now as this has been done now and has been a good job for this year.

2025/27) Finance

1. Appointment of new internal auditor

Tony Spence has offered his services to be our internal auditor. All councillors in agreement of formally appointing Tony Spence.

2. To consider draft accounts for end of 2024-25 financial year

Cllr N Truby has prepared a draft set of accounts for the financial year 2024-25. These accounts are not yet audited, a copy of the draft report is attached to this report.

The asset register needs to be checked for salt bins, Cllr Newton will check the locations of the salt bins and update at next meeting. Waste bin can be removed. Cllr Newton will also check the locations of the parish signs.

These accounts will now be passed to Tony Spence for approval and will be ready for the yearly audit.

3. Other Parish Financial matters.

- Receipt of the £4000 Precept.
- Online banking has been setup so there will be no more cheques. Payment will be made by BACS.

4. CIL funding

Cllr Newton read a statement what the Parish Council can use the ClL money for. This seemed to indicate that the Parish Council can use ClL money on maintenance including potholes but, the list was comprehensive but not exhaustive.

Pot hole filling, and other tasks, from the Enhanced highway maintenance scheme was £700 per day.

Suggestions from Cllr Passingham suggested some repairs to the burial ground fence, or the church gates. There was some unresolved discussion as to whether it can be done or not using ClL money.

We will ask the question at the annual parish meeting and see what the parishioners want to spend this money on. Any ideas put forward will then be checked to see if this is a viable CIL proposal. Some suggestions will be given to help simulate conversations.

Thank you for all the work to Cllr Newton.

5. Review current bank signatories

The current bank signatories are as follows:

Neil Truby, Chris Steel, John Passingham and Simon Hawes.

Going forward we will be doing all banking online. All councillors other than Cllr A Truby will now be signatories.

6. To consider opening an Instant Savings account

We are currently getting 1% interest within Lloyds on our money. Cllr N Truby proposed that we open an instant Savings account seconded by Cllr Passingham and agreed by all. Cllr N Truby will look at getting this opened with Lloyds.

2025/28) Parish Clerk wages review

The parish clerk has not had a wage review since joining in 2018, she had a 1.75% increase in 2021. Her current wage is £11.63 per hour, this means from the 1st of April 2025 this would be below the current minimum wage set at £12.21.

The clerk presented a pay banding scale produced by SALC but it was decided to submit a job description to SALC and allow them to set the pay band the clerk should be on. While this takes place Cllr N Truby proposed that the clerk is placed on £12.45 per hour from the 1st of April while the formal benchmarking process takes place.
